

Matfield Speeding (December 2025 report)

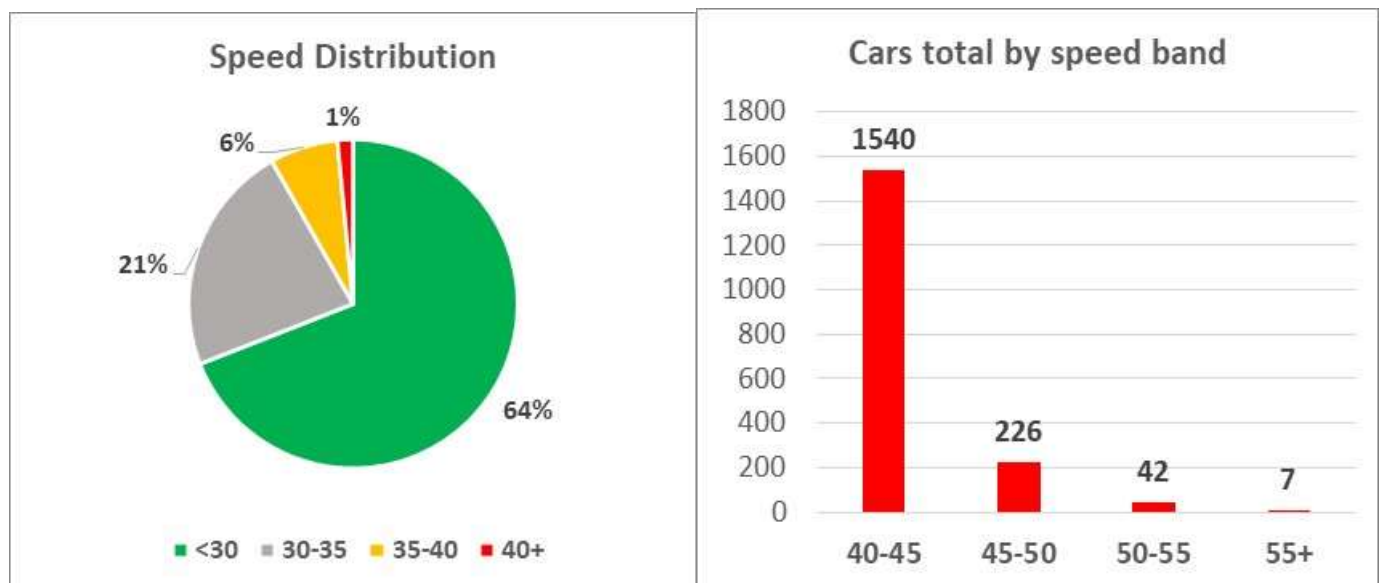
Village Hall: facing A21 (Nov 21st – Dec 11)

Level of 30 plus “speeders” halves – owing to roadworks

A little over 4,000 cars a day passed the speed indicator outside Matfield Village Hall on their way towards Paddock Wood. Encouragingly, only 6% of cars exceeded 35 mph. (This is the level police will consider for prosecution in a 30-mph zone.) A figure of 12% is more typical for this site. However, this improvement probably has much to do with the near constant roadworks on the Maidstone Road during this period.

Excessive Speeding drops

Around 1% of cars exceeded 40 mph which may not sound like many but this amounts to around 1800 cars during the period. This is half the normal level for this site. Despite the road works, seven cars managed to exceed 55 mph, one at around 8am in the morning.
