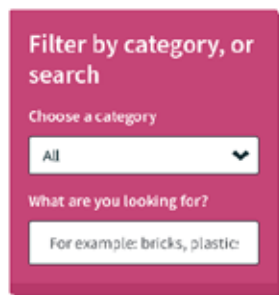

Collection of Bulky or Electrical Items

Contact TWBC to arrange a collection of bulky or electrical items. Collections cost £47 per collection slot.

A collection slot comprises up to four household items with a maximum of one fridge, or freezer, or fridge freezer.

If you are a resident in receipt of Band 1 Council Tax reduction scheme and of working age, or in receipt of Council Tax reduction scheme and of non-working age, you are entitled to one free collection every 90 days.

You must book a slot in advance using the Kent County Council booking system. Entry without booking is not permitted.

You can book up to one month in advance. If you cannot book a slot for the time you want, please keep trying. New slots are added each day and as bookings are cancelled availability may change.

Opening times: Monday to Saturday 8am to 4.30pm Sunday and bank holidays 9am to 4pm
