VACANCY – PARISH COUNCILLOR

The Parish Council is seeking to co-opt a new Member to return the number of Councillors to nine. To apply for the position, you must meet the following criteria:

- be at least 18 years old and
- not be disqualified, pursuant to s.80 of the 1972 Local Government Act and
- be a British citizen, an eligible Commonwealth Citizen or a citizen of any member state of the European Union, and
- meet **at least one** of the following four qualifications:
 - a. be registered as a local government elector of the Parish in which you wish to stand from the day of your application onwards.
 - b. have either occupied land or other premises in the Parish as owner or tenant during the whole of the 12 months before the day of your application and the day of election.
 - c. have resided in the parish or within 3 miles of the civil Parish boundary during 12 months before the day of your nomination and the day of election.
 - d. had your main or only place of work within the Parish during 12 months before the day of your application and the day of the election.
