NOTICE OF CASUAL VACANCY IN OFFICE OF COUNCILLOR

Local Government Act 1972 (Sec.87 (2))

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a casual vacancy has occurred in the Office of Councillor for the Parish Council following the resignation of Councillor James Spencer.

Rule 5(2) of The Local Elections (Parishes and Communities) (England and Wales) Rules, 2006 now applies.

The rule allows for **ten** local government electors for the Brenchley and Matfield Parish to request the Returning Officer to hold an election to fill the vacancy. If by the **27th September 2022 (fourteen days** excluding Dies Non, after the date of this notice) a request for an election to fill the said vacancy is made in writing to the Returning Officer:

by TEN electors for the said Parish, an election will be held to fill the said vacancy within 60 days.

If a request to hold an election is not received during the permitted time period Rule 5(5) of the above rules will apply. The Parish Council must, as soon as practicable after the expiry of the fourteen-day period, co-opt a person to fill the vacancy.
