

Matfield Speeding (March April 2025 data)

Matfield Hall: facing Kippings Cross (29 days data)

Speeders: A little under 4,000 cars a day passed through the village towards Kippings Cross. Around 13% of these were over 35 mph. This is well above the 11% recorded last month (admittedly in the opposite direction).

Dangerous speeds: Over 90 cars exceeded 50 mph during the 29-day period, **nearly three times** last month's number.

But what was astounding was that **9 were over 60 mph, including 2 over 70 mph.**

The bulk of these were late at night or very early in the morning. Such speeds are clearly dangerous but at least there are few pedestrians/other drivers put at risk at those times.

But **three of the over 55 mph drivers were in the 7-8am time slot**, meaning a greater number of pedestrians/other drivers are at risk. Obviously, at those speeds, any such accident is unlikely to be "minor"
