

Matfield Speeding (June data)

Matfield Hall: facing Paddock Wood

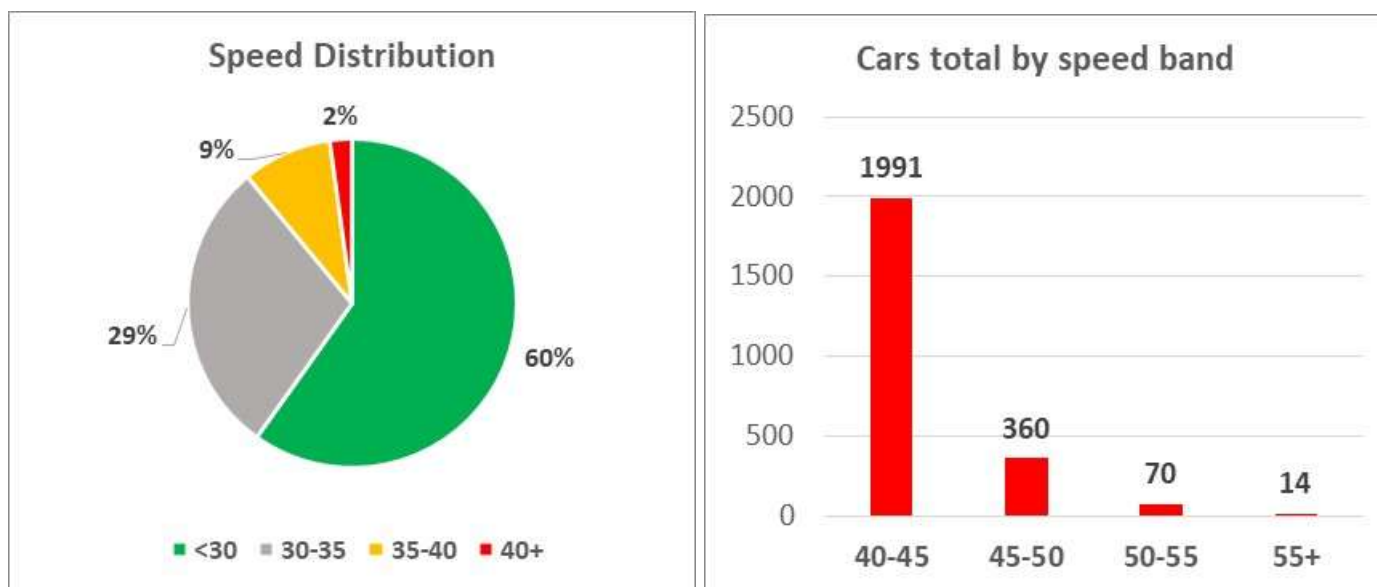
9% of cars exceeded 35 mph

Around 3,800 cars a day passed through the village from Paddock Wood. Around 9% of these were over 35 mph, which is a little below normal.

Excessive Speeding

Nearly 2,500 were over 40 mph during the period with 84 cars over 50 mph, including 14 above 55 mph. High as these numbers sound, it is less than half the level recorded the last time the SID (Speed Indicator Device) was in this position, possibly due to the Gedges Hill closures.

Although the number of 55mph plus speeders has dropped, the percentage doing so during daylight hours has increased. During June, the percentage of drivers speeding during daylight hours rose to 50% of the total compared to only 15% last time the SID was in this position.



The table to the right shows the dates and times of “day-light” speeders over 55 mph plus all speeders over 60 mph.
