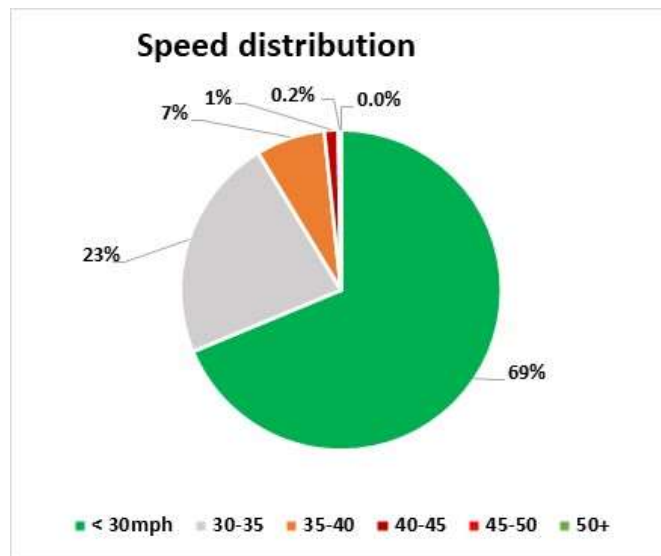


Parish Speeding (June 2024)

Matfield Village Hall SID, facing Kippings Cross: June 10 till June 30

Average daily traffic numbers coming from Kippings Cross were around 4,000, a fairly typical number. Around 350 (9%) were above 35 mph – similar to the number the last time the detector was in this position. But significantly lower than last month which measured cars coming from Paddock Wood.



The number of cars doing over 50 mph was 32, around two thirds of the typical number for this detector position. Most of these were early morning, before 7am or in the evening (after 8pm). Worryingly though, one car went through at around 8am, one at 3pm, and one at 7pm.

Please note that the Speedwatch Team can only work during daylight hours.

Brenchley Rd Coppers Lane SID, facing Matfield June 10 till June 29

The percentage of cars speeding over 35mph was around 7%.

This is at the low end of the typical range for Brenchley Road sites (7-15%). This may be because diversions boosted traffic making speeding more difficult. For example, volumes on Sunday 23 June were well over double normal levels.

Brenchley Road saw 18 cars over 50mph during the three-week period.

Again, this is below typical levels. Most were early morning or in the evening but there were cars doing over 50 mph at 10am, 1pm, 2pm, and 4pm.
