

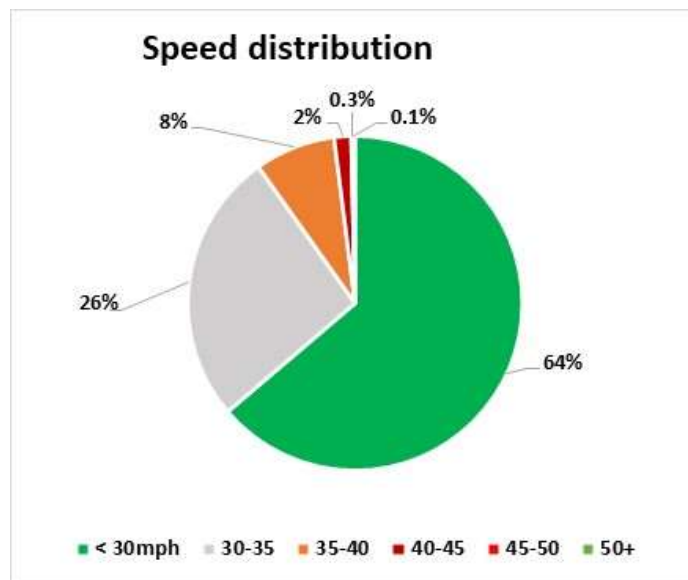
Parish Speeding (May June 2024)

Matfield Village Hall SID, facing Paddock Wood: May 13 till June 2

Average daily traffic number (one-way) was around 4,200 up from 3,200 in April (same site). April data was lower due to the closure of Gedges Hill.

Around 10% (410 a day) were over 35mph, the police definition of “speeding”.

Over the three weeks, nearly 70 cars were over 50 mph. As usual, most of these were late evening or very early morning when the Speedwatch Team cannot operate.



Brenchley Market Heath SID, facing Matfield May 13 till June 2

Average daily traffic number (one-way) was around 3,800, lower than in Matfield. But around 15% (5502 a day) were over 35 mph, a far higher percentage than Matfield’s 10%.

In total, Brenchley saw over 104 cars over 50mph during the three-week period. (Note that this does not adjust for around two days when data were not collected so the true number will have been higher)

Most of these were overnight or early morning. But nearly a third were during the working day.
